PLANNING IN A TIME OF LABOUR MARKET DISRUPTION

After 10 years of continuous economic growth, international, national and provincial forces have combined to create a 'perfect storm' of labour market impacts. The **2020 Summer Labour Market Conference** will gather together industry leaders to discuss the major forces impacting British Columbia's labour market, the industries most impacted by these forces, the occupations which will face greater challenges and the occupations well-poised to grow in the coming decade. Participants will get a 'blueprint understanding' of jobs in the year 2030.

DAY 1: Full Day — Thursday July 30th — 8am to 5pm

- The conference will open with coffee, tea, pastries and an opportunity for networking and personal connections. Our keynote address will explore the government's job creation and skills training response to the impact of the CORONA-19 outbreak and the ensuing economic crisis. Following this, we will discuss the Industry Training Authority's efforts to significantly increase the participation of women in apprenticeship.
- Our morning break-out groups will focus on five industries expected to dominate employment growth in the coming decade including: 1. health care; 2. technology; 3. tourism; 4. professional design; and 5. trades.
- Lunch is included for all conference participants.
- Our afternoon session will begin with an exploration of the critical role immigrants play in our evolving labour market. This will be followed by another set of break-out groups related to the five sustainable industries in British Columbia. Afterwards, we will provide presentations on the latest information relating to self employment and explore the important role Indigenous Canadians play in helping meet our future labour market needs.
- We will conclude our first day with a panel discussion exploring the growing impact of BC's gig economy.

DAY 2: Half Day — Friday July 31st — 8am to 12:30pm

- Day two starts with coffee, tea, pastries and an opportunity for networking and personal connections. Our Friday keynote address
 will explore the 2020 British Columbia Labour Market Outlook, outlining new resources, occupations to watch and projections for
 the year 2030.
- Friday will include career and job search support and resources for those with disabilities and gathering a better understanding of the impact of child care resources on labour market mobility.
- We'll conclude the conference with a panel discussion exploring the changing role of mature workers in British Columbia and strategies for assisting mature workers in connecting with available jobs.
