Bankruptcy and business closures are beginning to grip British Columbia. For the *'BC's Labour Market Briefing for September 2020'*, we will adopt an employer's perspective, to develop a strong sense of where they see the labour market going. - *Review of BC's health care sector, examining occupations in high-demand, strong educational pathways, industry trends, valuable resources and the impact of the pandemic on the labour force.*
- *Latest initiatives being undertaken by the Province of British Columbia and the Government of Canada to nurture hard-hit industries, support employers, grow the economy and create legislation that supports specific occupations.*
- *Summary of the very latest labour market research from local business, labour, financial, analytical, social policy and labour market research organizations.*
